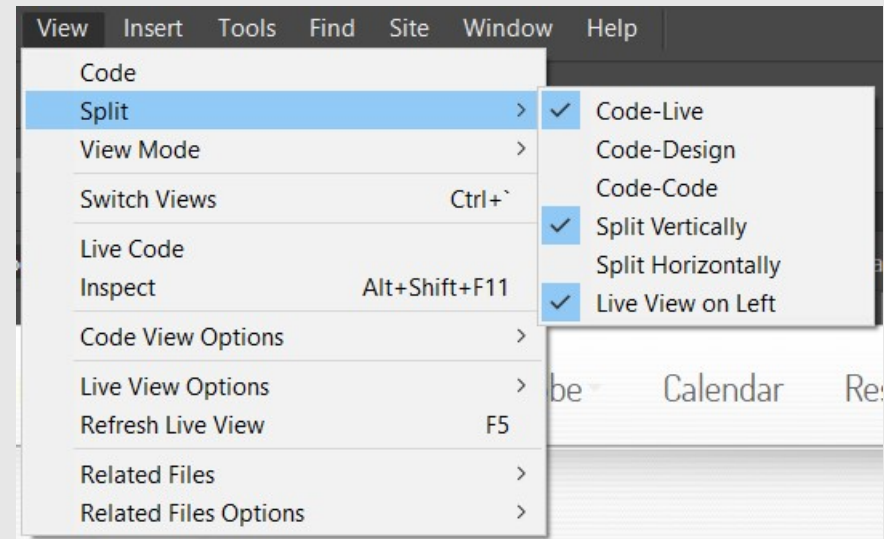
Ways to arrange your workspace

Viewing your design in a browser

Press F12 to view in a browser window.

To set your preferred browser, select

Edit | Properties | Real-time Preview

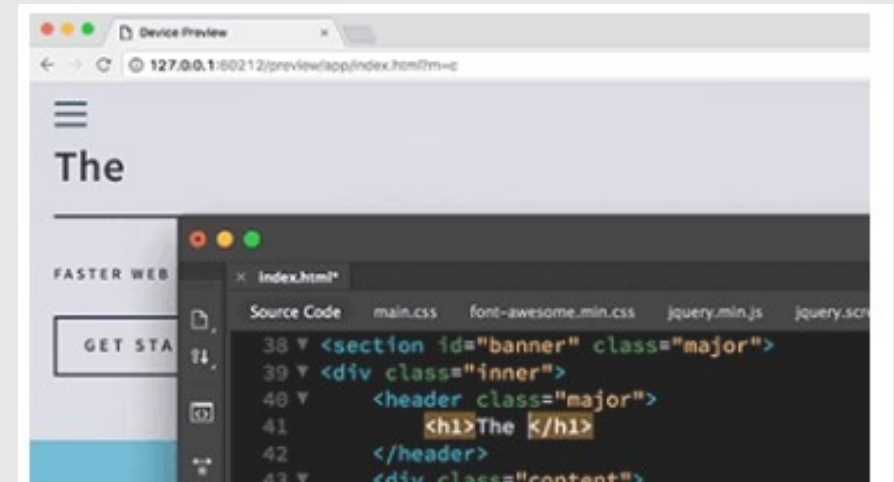

Real-time Preview **NEW**

Real-time Preview lets you view your site in a browser or a device, and changes that you make to your design or code appear instantly.

Press **F12** (Opt + F12 on Mac) to launch Real-time Preview in the browser.
